

## GSHS Board of Directors **Prospective Board Member Application**

The Prospective Board Member Application is in the form of a questionnaire and used to gather information about you and your interests for the GSHS Board of Directors to make appropriate decisions and recommendations for service to The Grand Strand Humane Society, Inc.'s Board of Directors ("Board"). The Application is part of the review and vetting process and not a guarantee for serving on the Board. Each Application is considered in its entirety to include previous experience, passion for the well-being of animals and availability to effectively and consistently contribute to the organization's success.

Candidates should possess an understanding of, and interest in, animal welfare and should appreciate the need to demonstrate a positive, professional public image that is in keeping with the philosophies and goals of GSHS. The Board provides strategic direction and assistance to the organization and possess a combination of work and personal experience that provides them with the necessary knowledge and understanding of the financial, administrative, and ethical and policy issues that may be put to the Board to successfully achieve its mission, goals and objectives.

Because member voting requirements include a minimum age of 18, the Board applies the same requirement to serve in any capacity on or with the Board and committees formed. Board candidates must be a member in good-standing of GSHS who are interested in animal welfare, governance, stewardship and strategic planning. Formal education is not a requirement for Board positions, although professional expertise is required for the Board to ensure an appropriate mix of perspectives with solid strategic contributions to ensure success.

Board members must be willing and have the confidence to challenge proposed policies, activities, initiatives, organizational structure and financial spending and management of the organization. However, the ability to challenge must be balanced with recognition of the need to work in a cooperative manner and demonstrate a style that values collaboration and unity to sustain and enhance community perception of the organization and its Board. All Board members are encouraged to make a personal financial commitment to GSHS and are required to seek out opportunities for financial support in the community through their personal and professional contacts.

Serving on the Board is without remuneration and requires a solid commitment of time. Requirements include attendance at Board meetings, GSHS events and fund-raising activities to fulfill its purpose. It is a shared vision and commitment to GSHS and the animals in the Shelter's care with transparency to the community, supporters and donors.
